

## Self-Neglect

Signs to look out for include poor personal hygiene, unkempt appearance, lack of suitable clothing, looking thin or frail, and consider if someone has unexplained bruising or wounds.



## Mental Capacity



Are you concerned that this person cannot consent to their vaccination due to possible lack of mental capacity such as those with dementia, a learning disability, mental health, and frailty?

## Domestic abuse and Coercion and Control

Does the person seem nervous or frightened, if they have come with another person are, they able to speak for themselves? Is there any evidence of physical violence such as bruising, cuts, verbal abuse and humiliation in front of others?



## Extremism



Consider if there are groups of people outside trying to influence people not to have their vaccine. Signs could be that they may express grievances, about covid-19 related issues such as lockdown, mask wearing, loss of job or other related injustices.

## Think Family

Try to consider all the factors of everyone in the home, and frequent visitors, including things like poverty, use of drugs, alcohol, domestic abuse, and mental ill health, which may impact upon all the family.



## Scams



Has the person said anything about paying for covid related services e.g. a covid test or early vaccination?

Signs to look out for include victims may now be experiencing financial hardship and show signs of self-neglect. They may talk about someone helpful who resolves issues, calls them or takes them for appointments, they may talk of unexpected final demands or refunds from a UK official, such as the HMRC or the local council, or talk of a new online relationship where they mostly have contact by telephone, email or on the internet and the person is in need of money.

## Modern Slavery

Signs to look out for include signs of physical or emotional abuse, appearing to be thin and frail, dishevelled or withdrawn, seeming under the control or influence of others, avoidance of eye contact, appearing frightened or hesitant to talk to strangers, appears nervous of officials whilst being vaccinated.
